



POLICY

For Enrolment in NSW School of Languages

The NSW School of Languages has a quota for government schools depending on their school population.

Currently this quota is 6 students for Killarney Heights High School. As there are limited places, the process below determines how students are selected for these places.

1. A student would like to study a year 11 and 12 continuers course for languages taught at Killarney Heights High School in junior years, if we do not have enough students to run a class eg Japanese Continuers, French Continuers
2. A student would like to study Ext Japanese or Ext French if we do not have enough students to run a class.
3. A student in year 11 or 12 has a family background in the language they would like to study if there is not a Saturday school program that is easily accessible.
 - a. We only offer NSW school of Languages to Years 9 and 10 in exceptional circumstances as we are not able to effectively supervise students during the time they are not doing the school elective (the one they miss for the language). Eg A circumstance for enrolment might be that the student has studied the language in year 9 at another school and has enrolled in Killarney for year 10.
4. Only if the quota is not filled by the above: Students who want to study a Beginner's language course in Year 11 and 12 (e.g. Korean Beginners).
5. If the quota is not filled by the above, we are able to enrol students in year 9 and 10 for family background languages providing supervision is available at the timetabled elective time for the line they are not studying at KHHS.

Once selected for NSW School of Languages, students must pay the fee for the course, attend all lessons, submit assessments and follow the course with diligence and sustained effort.
